Notice, Visitor Waiver, & Health Declaration

Notice & Waiver

Covid-19 is an infectious disease presently active in Outagamie County and surrounding communities. Some infectious carriers are asymptomatic and unaware of their condition. The Thompson Center on Lourdes (TCOL) is concerned about the transmission of COVID-19. Although TCOL has taken steps to increase sanitation and distance between visitors during this pandemic, there is still a risk of contracting this disease in any public setting. By visiting TCOL and participating in activities you are assuming that risk. By signing below, you state that you are aware of the risk posed to you and agree to hold TCOL harmless if you contract COVID-19. You also agree to increase personal sanitation, cover your mouth when sneezing or coughing, and maintain social distancing when participating in programs on the premises.

Health Declaration

I hereby declare that I have not been sick, had a fever, been diagnosed with COVID-19 or been in contact with anyone who was sick, had a fever, or has been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past two weeks. I agree not to participate in programs or visit the premises until I have been without symptoms for a minimum of two weeks if I become sick, have a fever, or come into contact with anyone who has been sick or had a fever. Furthermore, I agree to inform TCOL if I become sick, have a fever, or I test positive for COVID-19 and allow them to communicate that fact to the TCOL community at large to reduce the risk of further transmission.
